European Location Framework Project to be joint organiser of data modelling workshop

The European Location Framework (ELF) Project is delighted to be part of the organising committee of a workshop focusing on data modelling and model-driven implementation of data distribution.

The event, at the Danish Geodata Agency in Copenhagen from 28 to 30 January 2015, aims to define the challenges associated with increased demand for well-documented data in known models as standardised web services. In doing so, it will identify relevant research topics and encourage the development of best practice recommendations.

National e-government initiatives require the seamless modelling of spatial and non-spatial data. Whilst INSPIRE regulates GML application schemas and web-service standards, the ELF Project brings national spatial data infrastructures together in a pan-European context. Handling code lists, linked data and change packages and notifications are just a few of the issues expected to be discussed.

The workshop is being jointly organised by EuroSDR, the Association of Geographic Information Laboratories for Europe (AGILE), Open Geospatial Consortium (OGC) and the ELF Project.
